Management, Staff & Volunteers

LOV Summer Recreation in the Parks' on-site staff of employee park leaders, assistant leaders, and "Kid-Koach" community volunteers are trained to keep your child safe, organized and having fun.

All park employees are over the age of 15, 18+ are background checked. 13-15 year olds may volunteer at our warehouse. Volunteers are supervised by adults, and never left alone with any child. Sorry - no before or after care.

Changes have come to Summer Camp.

This year, we've accommodated State, County and City mandates so we can once again bring this program to our community. We'll be hosting up to 100 children each session - you can only sign up for ONE session of Camp per family. If registration spaces become available after June 1, we will make additional session registration available.

All activities happen in health-compliant settings, with daily no-contact temperature checks, face masks, sanitizing and social distancing practices observed. See the CA Dept. of Public Health, www.covid19.ca.gov for the guidelines we're following. Our Camp handbook will be available on site.

How To Register

A release of liability form and proof of residency will be required.

There is a per-child, non-refundable \$20 fee to register. Single session registration only - additional spaces will be announced in early June as they become available.

2021 Camp may require masks and social distancing practice. We will provide extra masks as needed but prefer you supply your child with these health-conscious items.
